Torbjørn Rødland 132 BPM 13' | DVD Loop | 2005 | Original Music -Sex in Dallas (D. Ducaruge / A. Walter)

Using video like a still camera to capture landscapes, movement and people as they pulse of their own accord to 132 beats per minute of the title. This time signature is the most frequently used in contemporary house music and the sequence of seemingly unconnected images here act in part as a music video, in part as an exploration of movement in photography and stillness in the moving image.

Pipilotti Rist Pickelporno, 12'30 | Video transferred to DVD | 1992 | colour | sound

Pickelporno uses a kaleidoscope of images of the body, exploring it with close up shots from the perspective of sexual partners. At once hypnotic and repellent, Rist evokes the tactile sensations of skin, hair, breasts, genitalia, eyes, fingers, here shown over-sized and without restraint in an attempt to make visible the feelings of sexual intimacy.

Olaf Breuning First 7'41 | DV | 2003 colour | sound | starring Brian Kerstetter

A shorter version of his film *Home 1*, *First* is a genre bending short recounting the boredom of a somewhat petulant tourist and his attempts to amuse himself, getting his kicks from chasing down an Amish man stripping him down and sticking an E.T. mask on him. This genre mixing short takes in films as diverse as The Ring, to Eminem's 8 Mile, E.T. to Witness in its references.
